PCM (Pulse Code Modulation) is the state-of-the-art digital recording technique which electronically records and plays sounds back with remarkable tonal authenticity, clarity and accuracy. Lowrey Genius PCM Digital Stereo Rhythm has 16 digitally recorded percussion rhythm instruments stored in its computer memory bank. For example, there are bass drum, snare drum, snare drum rim shot, open hi-hat cymbals, closed hi-hat cymbals, tambourine, conga drum, tuned conga drum, hand clap, low tom-tom drum, hi tom-tom drum, etc. You have all the rhythm instruments required to orchestrate the wide variety of rhythm accompaniments programmed into the Genius Style and Rhythm Cartridges.

The Genius cartridge determines which rhythm instruments are called upon to produce the rhythm accompaniment. The end result is new Lowrey rhythm that rivals the sounds of live musicians playing. Listen for the remarkably crisp, clean sounds of the bass drum, snare drum, cymbals and other percussive instruments.

The model G-201 also incorporates a visual advanced feature reference guide for both the upper and lower keyboards. Included are the modes of operation available when using Genius Rhythm Cartridges. This information is located to the left of the upper keyboard.
